BUSINESS

1. Annual Report of the Executive Committee

Report attached. The Secretary presented the Annual Report, and highlighted the following items:

- steady increase of members in force (up 25%)
- publications: SILAS website and IMSLA open-access journal keep growing (more than 35,000 visits in April)
- grants programme: four winners this year, €3,400 granted
- successful first conference held in Galway 2007 - Now planning the next conference on 15-18 July 2009 in Morelia, Mexico

2. Treasurer's and Auditor's Reports

Reports attached. Unpaid membership fees continue to be a problem, with more than half of membership owing their fees. The treasury function successfully moved from Switzerland to Ireland, now managed by the Administration Officer Andrés Romera in Waterford.

3. Fundraising

The Fundraising Report by the Fundraising Officer John Kennedy was presented and approved without further debate. Voluntary help is requested from Members to help with pulling together contributions from the Executive Committee to the SILAS business plan.

4. Other languages than English

Pádraig M. Ó Beaglaoich proposed that SILAS appoints an Irish language officer to produce information documents targeted at agencies related to the Irish language. Fourteen Members enthusiastically endorsed the proposal. Four Members expressed their concern that the use of Irish language could create barriers and divisions, especially in an organisation with a wide and international scope of interests. It was agreed that this proposal does not include SILAS publications (e.g., website, IMSLA journal), and does not imply that Irish may be considered in any form having an official language status for the Society. Additionally, officers for French, Portuguese, Spanish and other languages may be appointed as required by the Executive Committee.

MOTION: To appoint Pádraig M. Ó Beaglaoich as SILAS Irish Language Officer to liaise with Irish-speaking agencies and audiences.

5. TV Documentary Series

Pádraig M. Ó Beaglaoich also proposed to explore the possibility of producing a series of documentaries about the Irish in Latin America, the Caribbean and Iberia.

MOTION: Pádraig M. Ó Beaglaoich to make contacts to undertake the production of a series of documentaries about the Irish in Latin America, the Caribbean and Iberia.

6. Executive Committee Elections in 2009

Edmundo Murray reminded Members that, according to the Constitution, next year there will be elections for the new Executive Committee. Current Executive Committee members may be re-elected for the term 2009-2012. Edmundo Murray will not run for re-election. He added that everyone wishing to sit in the EC or cooperating with SILAS should start working now. Finally, he Furthermore, I thanked the voluntary work of the following persons: Andrés Romera, Administration Officer; John Kennedy, Fundraising Officer; Claire Healy, IMSLA co-editor; Patricia Novillo-Corvalán, IMSLA associate editor; Juan Pablo Alvarez, IMSLA and SILAS website production manager; Oliver Marshall, conferences and publications; and all others who help with their time, their money and their ideas.

2007-2008

1. MEMBERSHIP

The last twelve months have been significant for SILAS. A continued increase of 25 per cent in membership is the result of 28 new Members who joined from 1 May 2007 to 30 April 2008. As of 30 April 2008, the Society has 135 Members, including 111 Senior Members, 17 Student Members and 7 Honorary Members.

Chart 1. SILAS Membership 2003-2008 (to 30 April 2008)

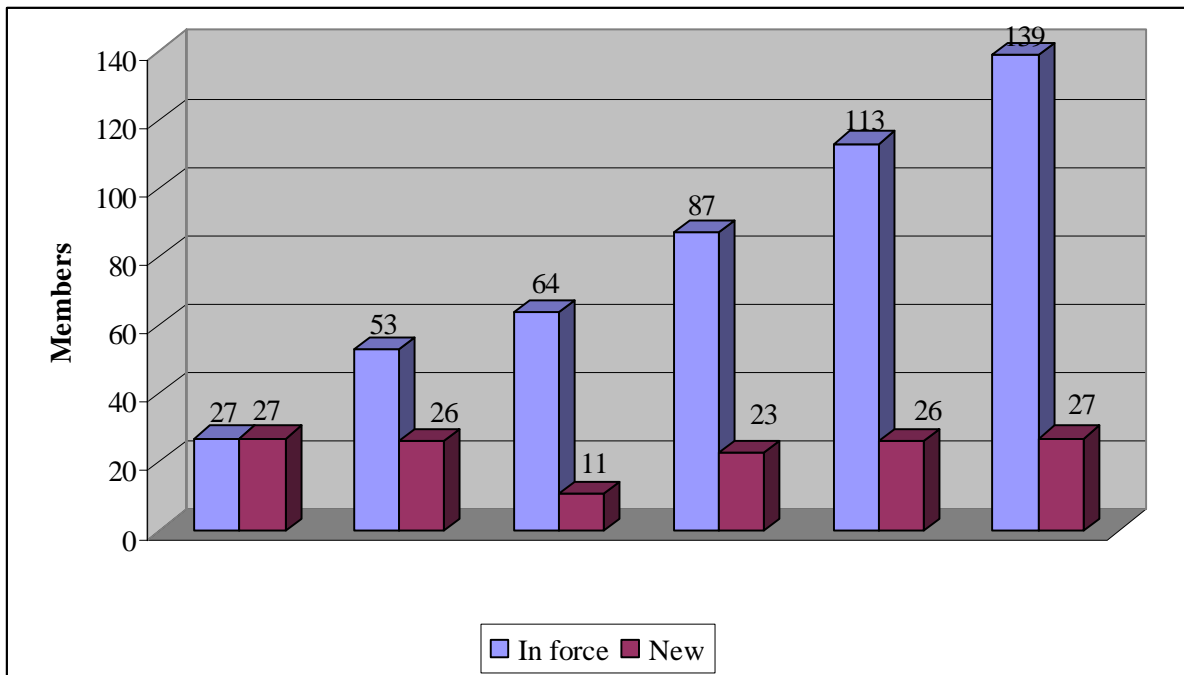
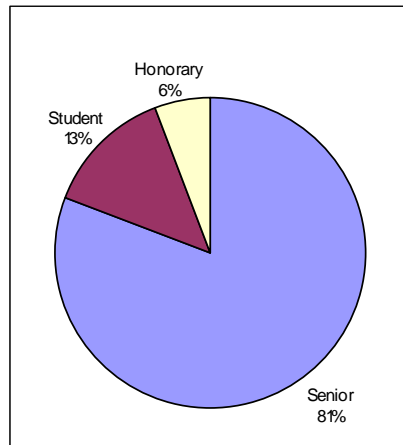


Chart 2. SILAS Membership by Type of Members

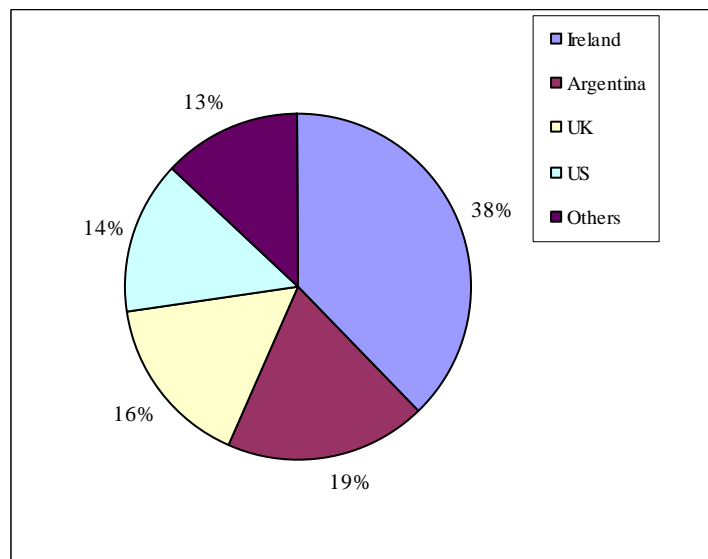


Chart 3. Members by Country of Residence (percentage)

Unpaid membership fees represent the most important financial issue of the Society, and have a direct effect on the activities that SILAS undertakes and its possibilities in the future.

In 2008 the percentage of unpaid to invoiced fees declined to 50.21 per cent (from 76 per cent in 2007). However, a significant portion of Members did not pay their fees. Fees due are owed by 66 Members, i.e. more than half of Membership (52 per cent, not including the Honorary Members).

Chart 4. Unpaid Fees (to 30 April 2008)

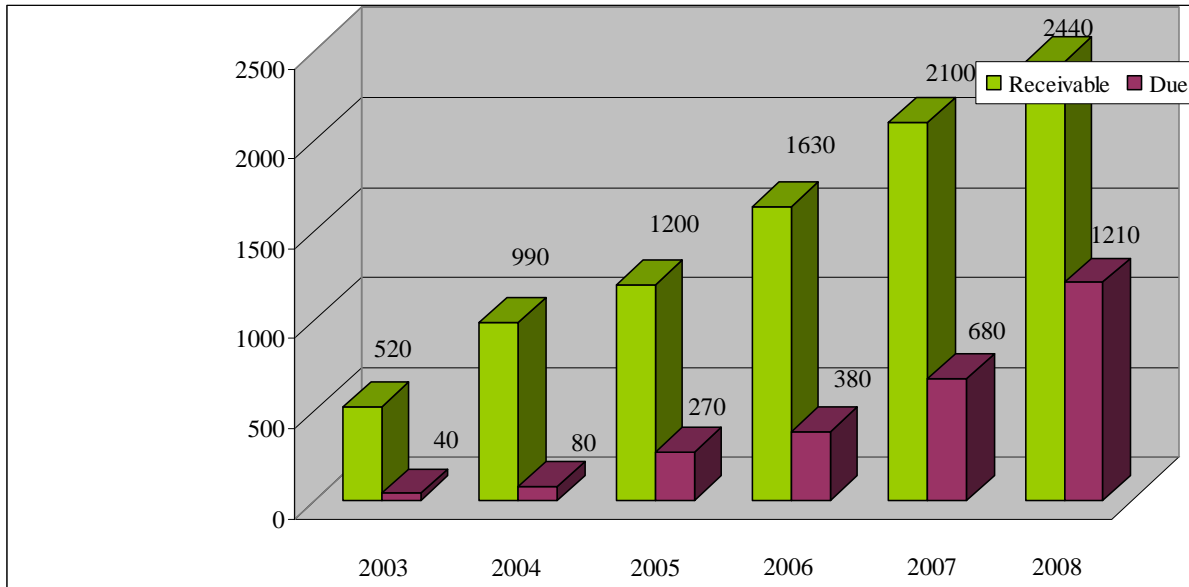
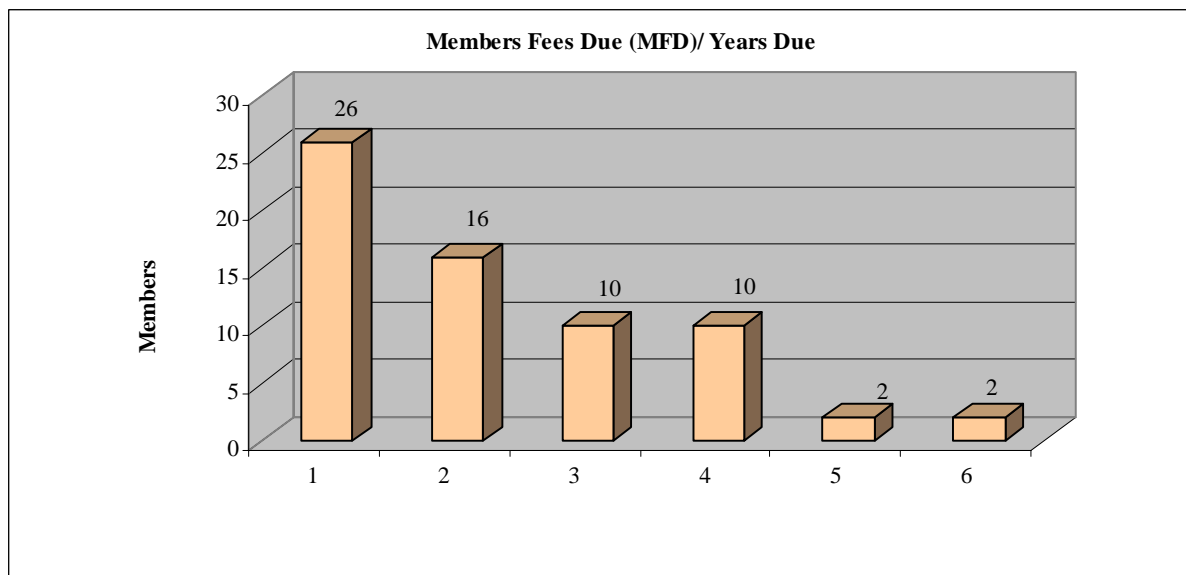


Chart 5. Number of Members with Fees Due (to 30 April 2008)



2. TREASURY

The Treasury function continued to be managed in Switzerland until 28 June 2007, when Andrés Romera was appointed Administration Officer. From 1 October 2007 the accounts have been managed in Ireland and in Euros. The UBS bank account in Swiss Francs

continued until the end of 2007, whilst a new bank account in Euros was opened at Bank of Ireland (Waterford branch) which is now the only bank account opened by SILAS. The authorised signatures are Andrés Romera and Sharon Newman. The Swiss Visa/MasterCard service establishment has been cancelled, and a new credit card account will be opened through Bank of Ireland.

3. PUBLICATIONS

SILAS's website (www.irlandeses.org) is available since 2003. From January 2005 the website includes an open-access journal, *Irish Migration Studies in Latin America* (IMSLA), which is published every four months. This publication is registered under ISSN 1661-6065 and is given volume and issue numbers. A paginated version is published in the website in pdf format, so readers who need to cite articles are provided the complete reference. Furthermore, a hardcopy edition (print-on-demand) is offered to libraries and institutions by subscription (one subscription to date).

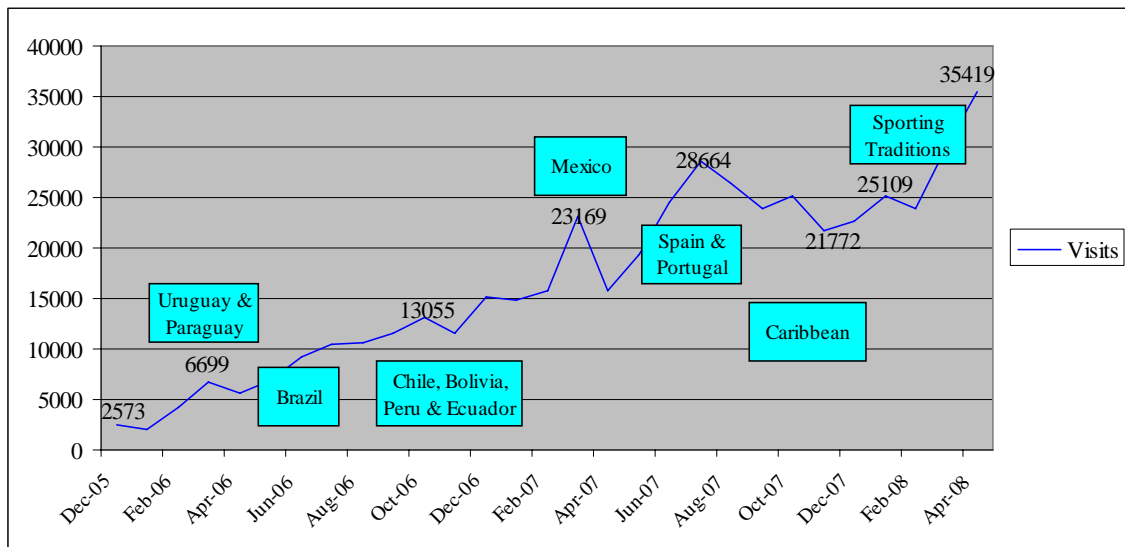

Chart 6. Website Visits (December 2005 to April 2008)

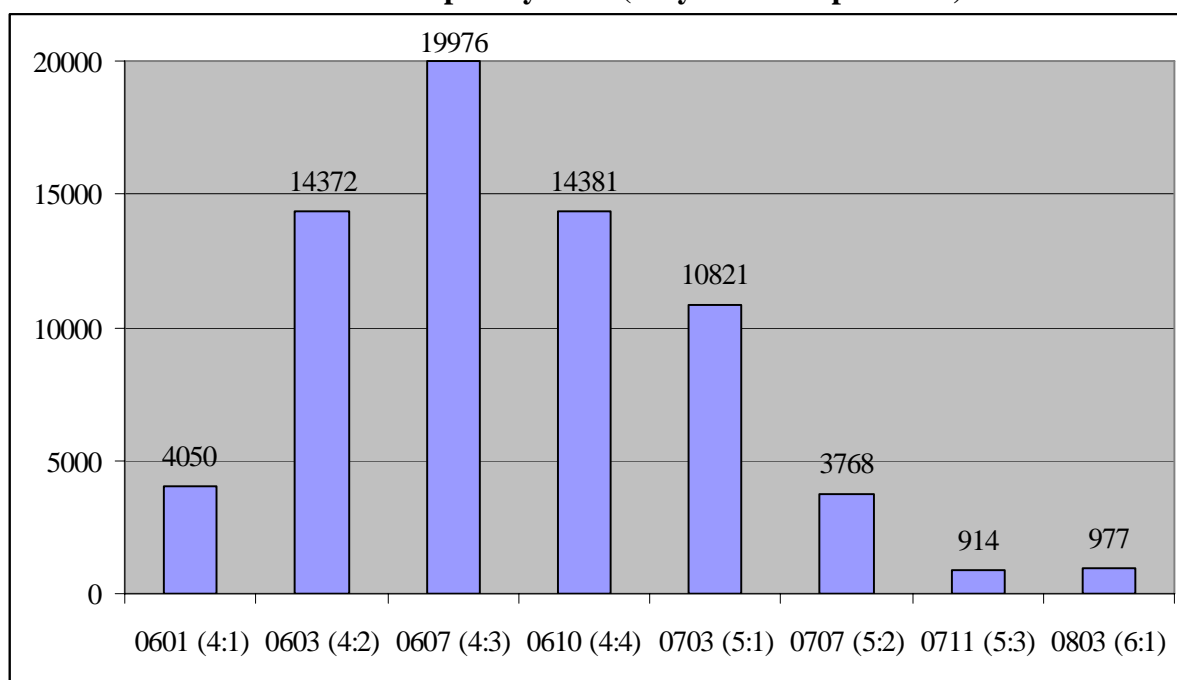


Monthly visits increased from a few dozens in the first publications of 2003 to 35,419 in April 2008. Average daily visits reached 1,180 in April 2008, with a record highest peak of

1,489 on 4 April 2008, after the announcement of the "Sporting Traditions" special issue of IMSLA (Vol. 6, N° 1).

Another key indicator is the number of downloaded pdf files (comparable to readership in a printed publication). In the twelve-months period from May 2007 to April 2008, there were 46,042 pdf files downloaded from the website (62.8 per cent higher than the previous comparable period). The most successful IMSLA issue to date continues to be the special one dedicated to Ireland and Brazil (July 2006, Vol. 4, N° 3), which was downloaded 19,976 times since its launching.

We are thankful to the growing number of contributors and to Members and friends who submitted materials for publication and who provided constant feedback. The editorial and production staff has been enhanced by the voluntary work of Claire Healy and Edmundo Murray (Co-Editors), Patricia Novillo-Corvalán (Associate Editor), Helen Kelly (Associate Editor, temporary) and Juan Pablo Alvarez Pearce (Production Manager).

In addition to the SILAS website and IMSLA journal, a publication with a selection of papers presented at the Galway conference in 2007 is being prepared. Whilst financial support for this project has still to be secured, an initial selection and editorial guideline has been arranged.

4. GRANTS PROGRAMME

The Grants Programme of the Society for Irish Latin American Studies (SILAS) was introduced in March 2004 to support innovative and significant research in the different aspects of migrations between Ireland and Latin America. The grants programme name is **Irish Latin American Research Fund**.

Grants up to 1,000 Euros are awarded to exceptionally promising students, faculty members or independent scholars to help support their research and writing leading to the publication or other types of communication of their projects. Awards are selected on the basis of a well-developed research plan that promises to make a significant contribution to a particular area of study about the Irish and Latin America. Typically, grants funds are used to pay for travel expenses to distant archives.

Every year three prestigious scholars seat on the selection committee to assess the research proposals and award grants to the best projects. The Irish Latin American Research Fund is open to faculty, advanced university students, and independent scholars throughout the world. Funding for the grants programme is obtained from individuals and private sources, namely from SILAS members and friends.

To date, nineteen grant recipients were awarded Euro 12,300.

5. MANUSCRIPTS AND RARE BOOKS COLLECTION

The Manuscripts and Rare Books Collection (MRBC) was created in May 2005 to allow Members and others to contribute to the preservation of Irish heritage and aid historical research on relations between Ireland and Latin America.

SILAS has signed a twenty-five years repository contract with the Max von Buch Library of Universidad de San Andrés (Buenos Aires). This library provides optimal security and technical conditions for documents and rare books belonging to SILAS, its Members and friends. The library staff is trained to preserve records using the latest available technology. Furthermore, the Max von Buch Library has been collecting a number of invaluable holdings of the British and Irish communities in Argentina, including among others the most complete collection of the *Standard* newspaper in existence in a public library (1861-1959), the Cecilia Grierson Papers (1859-1934), and the records of 'The Strangers Club' of Buenos Aires (1841-1981). To this, SILAS added the **Anastasia Joyce Papers (1844-1881)** donated by Mary Anglim, including the letters to Martin Murphy of Co. Wexford. The collection has been received in Buenos Aires, was classified and catalogued by the staff library and is available to researchers.

6. CONFERENCES

The first SILAS conference was held on 27-30 June 2007 at the National University of Ireland, Galway. The conference was organised in conjunction with the Fifth Galway Conference on Colonialism, and the venue was the Irish Studies Centre at Galway.

Since 2006, Claire Healy and Oliver Marshall have been working on the organisation of the Galway conference. The sponsors included the Cultural Division at the Irish Department of Foreign Affairs (Euro 7,000), the Brazilian Embassy to Ireland (Euro 500), Smurfit Kappa Group (Euro 500), and individual donations (Euro 400). These funding was used to contribute to travel expenses of Latin American participants, the organization and advertising of the conference, and the publication of the proceedings.

The call for papers attracted numerous proposals, and twenty-seven papers were presented arranged in nine panels. The significant dispersion of countries and cultures in Latin America provided a three-day panoramic tour covering Irish people and cultures in many countries and areas (Table 5).

Another conference, the Second Symposium of Irish Studies was organized by the Brazilian Association of Irish Studies (ABEI), the National University of La Pampa and the National University of San Martín - IDAES (Instituto de Altos Estudios Sociales), Instituto Histórico de la Ciudad de Buenos Aires, Academia de Historia de la Ciudad de Buenos Aires, Ministerio "Puertas del Bicentenario" and *The Southern Cross* paper. The Symposium was held on 5-7 September 2007 at Manzana de las Luces, Buenos Aires, with the support of the Embassy of Ireland to Argentina.

Further to a decision taken during last year's AGM, the next SILAS conference will be held in the Americas. Mexico was selected as host country, and the conference will be held on 15-18 July 2009 in Morelia, central Mexico. This conference will be organized by the Universidad Michoacana de San Nicolás de Hidalgo and Universidad Popular Autónoma del Estado de Puebla. Organizing committee members include Lourdes de Ita, Martín Pérez Acevedo, Miguel Ángel Sánchez de Armas, Laura Izarra and Edmundo Murray.
